

Category	Requirements for the carriage of hazardous goods, including maximum quantity
Ammunition/Arms	<p><u>Arms</u> All firearms must be accompanied by a valid EU firearms pass and/or arms permit or the equivalent. The above must be available for inspection by either the booking staff, the port security staff or the ship's crew. Persons transporting firearms should be aware of requirements, to ensure safe storage of weapons and ammunition.</p> <p><u>Ammunition</u> A maximum of 1,000 cartridges of UN 0012 and UN 0014 class 1.4S per vehicle, which should be transported in the manufacturer's original packaging, is permitted without any documentation. Quantities exceeding this amount must be declared and transported in accordance with the full provisions of the IMDG Code.</p> <p>Arms and ammunition must also be handled in accordance with the Danish arms legislation in effect at any time.</p>
Gas cylinders	Propane/Butane/Helium (maximum 3 cylinders, whose total weight must not exceed 47 kg). The bottles may not be hooked up and must be securely fastened. Cleaned cylinders require proof of certification.
Hybrid cars and the like	Only recognised manufactured models with standard specifications or where documentation can be provided that any changes have been made by a competent certified mechanic.
Diving equipment	<p>There can be a maximum of six cylinders of size F or less (note that size F has a water capacity of 9.4 litres, with approximate dimensions of 930 mm x 140 mm or up to 60 L total water capacity) per vehicle, containing either UN 1002 AIR, COMPRESSED, UN 1072 OXYGEN, UN 3156 COMPRESSED GAS OXIDISING N.O.S (Oxygen, Nitrogen). Cylinders must be declared to the ship's officer and land personnel before loading. No other hazardous goods (e.g. Class 2.1 flammable gasses, Class 3 hazardous liquids) may be carried in the same vehicle as the diving gasses.</p>
Household goods	Flammable paint and paint-related material (max. 10 L combined). Disposable gas cylinder (max. 1 L) for gas burner or similar.
Fire extinguishers	Small fire extinguishers are allowed up to a maximum total weight of 5 kg per vehicle/caravan/trailer.
Fireworks	Private vehicles may not carry fireworks.
Animal feed	Allowed for transport are Small "horse" trailer with animal. 3 standard size bales. Bales must be covered if outside the vehicle. Large "horse" trailer. Additional bales can be transported inside the vehicle, up to a maximum of 3 bales per animal.
Items carried in personal luggage	Allowed for transport are Personal care or hygiene products, such as hair spray and toiletries. Lithium batteries in ordinary electronic equipment, such as cameras, computers and toys, may also be carried.
Self-inflatable life jackets/pyrotechnics	Allowed for transport are Valid flares and life jackets. Maximum per vehicle of 6 x life jackets, 6 x hand-held signal flares, 4 x parachute flares and 2 smoke signals for use in recreational craft.

Medical oxygen	<p>Private vehicles used for transporting sick or disabled persons can have up to 6 cylinders, size 'F' or smaller cylinders (i.e. up to 60 L total water capacity) containing UN 1072 OXYGEN, COMPRESSED.</p> <p>The patient must present a letter from a physician stating that the patient requires medical oxygen.</p> <p>In addition to the above terms, the ship must be informed upon booking, and use of oxygen on board the ship is only permitted in non-smoking areas designated by the ship's captain.</p>
Petrol/Diesel	<p>Allowed for transport are in a suitable and safe container (maximum quantity 25 L per vehicle). The container must be securely fastened.</p> <p>If the quantity exceeds 5 L per vehicle, it must be declared to the ship's officer.</p>
